Guidelines for Concours Competitors

Concours is needed to preserve the originality of MGs and set standards for future generations of members. They also provide first hand reference for members rebuilding their cars.

You are encouraged to pre-enter the Concours, this will save you time on the day.

Cars **must** be driven to and from the event.

Please note that competitors who have had a Class/Major Trophy win in a qualifying Concours in the last three years must enter the appropriate Premier Class (not applicable to Yesterday's Competitors). Note the car is the winner, not the owner.

Please **sign in at the Concours Control between 09:00 & 10:20** and collect your Class number card. Pre-entries will be given a plaque.

Please park your car in the appropriate area for the Class as directed by the marshals.

Your Class number card should be displayed prominently on your car (suggested position is on windscreen).

You will need to prepare your car for judging with attention to general cleanliness and ensuring the interior and boot are free from all personal effects. The vehicle should be as it left the factory/showroom.

Wherever possible the Concours is judged by experienced judges drawn from the various Registers.

Please ensure someone responsible **remains with your vehicle until the judging is completed** – this is very important, as your vehicle cannot be fully judged if you are absent and marks will be lost. You or your representative will be required to open the boot and bonnet etc. judges may also check the oil in the engine and ask for the vehicle to be started, at their discretion.

Do, please, allow the judges room to judge.

Judging will cover all aspects of the vehicle with special attention to originality.

Once the Class winners have been determined there will be a further process to determine the winners of the Major Trophies.

Overall results will be posted in the Concours control area in accordance with the timetable of events.

At the end of the event there will be a prize giving ceremony. If possible do please attend to support your fellow competitors and also, if applicable, receive your prize. If you are unable to attend please nominate someone to collect on your behalf, as it is not possible for the Club to forward trophies.

Any queries may be addressed to the Organisers on the day. The Organisers decision in all matters is final.
