



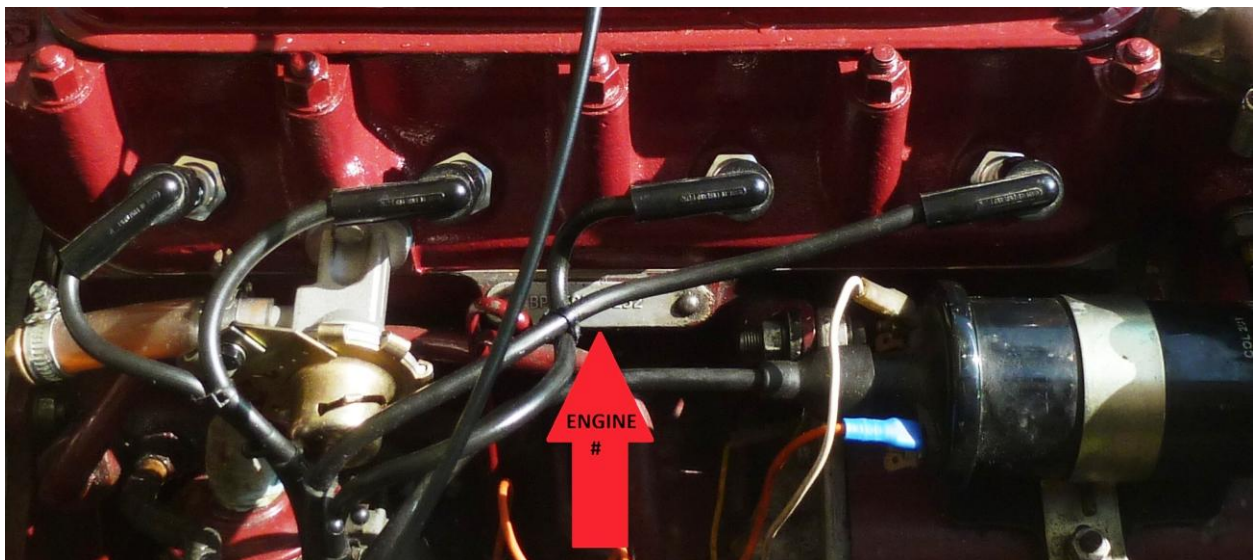
MGA - Location of Identification Numbers - UK & North American Cars (excl CKD Cars)



Chassis No.- Usually the chassis number can be found stamped into the top of the cross member which runs from the inner cill area to the transmission tunnel on the right side of the car (under the carpet roughly below the steering column). More often than not it has worn off over the years. At the time of production the same chassis number would have been stamped on the ID tag (VIN plate) screwed to the heater shelf.



Engine No. - Stamped into a plate attached to the top of the right side of the block.



(Note – on Australian CKD cars the number is stamped into the casting – no tag)





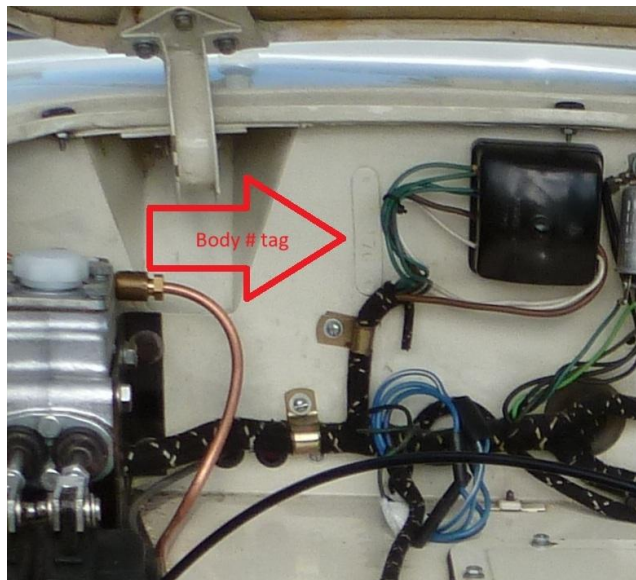
MGA - Location of Identification Numbers - UK & North American Cars (excl CKD Cars)



Engine Block No. - Found on the left side of the engine block just above the engine mount bracket. Look for a large raised number cast in the block, 1500, 1600, 1622, or 1800. This indicates of the original source of the block.



Body No. - Can be found on a tag welded to the firewall, to the right of the master cylinder.
