

# MGCC RACE MEETING MALLORY PARK Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2016 FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

This meeting is organised by The MG Car Club and is governed by the general Competition Rules of the MSA. Incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA, additional supplementary regulations and any written instructions the organisers issue for the event. These Final Instructions should be read in conjunction with the MGCC Standing Race Regulations and any further instructions or bulletins issued by the organisers. The Meeting will be run under MSA. Clubmans Permit No 93042.

The event is open to all fully elected members of the organizing club and to members of the following invited clubs: PCGB, FISCAR, MSCC, MGOC, Ferrari Owners Club, BRSCC, BARC, 750 MC, CSCC, VSCC, AMOC, MSVR, HSCC, STOC, and to registered competitors in any of the Championship/Series races.

### 1. TICKETS

Enclosed you will find your four personal admittance tickets and a paddock pass. Competitors are able to gain access to the paddock on Saturday from 16.00 hrs onwards. For those arriving on Saturday the Paddock Diner will be open and Serving Food from 17.00 till 20.00hrs on Saturday evening. The Café does not accept Cards, it is cash only.

# 2. PADDOCK

Competitors are urged to park in the area allocated for their championship or race in accordance with the enclosed paddock plan. We request that you minimise the presence of all non-essential vehicles (road cars, etc.) and park these in the outer car park. No racing engines may be run before 09.15 or after 18.00. The paddock gate will be open till 09.05 in the morning and then again at the lunch break. After the lunch break the paddock gate may be open at certain times but this cannot be guaranteed. Otherwise it will remain closed for the duration of the afternoon until racing is completed. At all other times Access to the race Paddock will only be via the pedestrian footbridge from the outer paddock.

# 3. SIGNING ON

Signing on will take place in the Race Admin office on the ground floor of the Race Control building from 07.45 on Sunday. Competitors who are subsequently unable to take part in the meeting <u>MUST</u> submit an orange official withdrawal form - available from signing on.

# 4. SCRUTINEERING

Scrutineering will take place in scrutineering bay from 08.15 on Sunday - please see timetable for your race. Competitors who arrive too early will be turned away.

# 5. MANDATORY BRIEFING

There are no drivers briefings scheduled but if any briefings are deemed to be required they will be bulletined and advised via paddock tannoy.

# 6. DRIVERS NEW TO THE CIRCUIT

Drivers who have not raced at the Mallory Park circuit in its current configuration before <u>must</u> attend one of the Briefings, <u>before</u> they are allowed to qualify. These will take place in <u>the Briefing Room next to Race Admin</u>, at <u>08.00 & 09.00</u>. Failure to attend may result in a fine, licence endorsement or exclusion from the meeting (G5.3.8).

# 7. QUALIFYING & RACE

Please familiarise yourself with the layout of the Paddock and Assembly Areas. You must form up in the Assembly Area at least 20 minutes before the start of your Practice and Race (listen for the PA announcements). At the conclusion of each you should leave the circuit via the paddock gate at the Lake Esses – and parc fermé as instructed. The Club reserves the right to run continuous qualifying - Please see latest MGCC Standing Race Regulations for an explanation.

## 8. PIT LANE

The Entry to the Pit Lane is off the main straight Between the Start/Finish line and the Pedestrian Bridge. There are no Pit Stop races at this meeting and any car that enters the paddock via the 'Esses' Gate will be deemed to have retired from that qualifying or race.

## 9. AMENDMENTS TO SUPPLEMENTARY REGS.

Currently there are no amendments.

### 10. AWARDS AND GARLANDS

Trophies and garlands for all MGCC Races will be presented 30 minutes after the race (or second race for double headers), in The Club's 'Welcome Centre', which is in the Hailwood Suite.

All races at this meeting will be determined by time - see enclosed timetable.

# 15. TRANSPONDERS

Competitors are reminded that their car must be fitted with a Red AMB Transponder and its number must be advised to the organisers before the meeting. A limited number will be available for hire from TSL at the circuit.

# 16. START PROCEDURE

All races will have a Standing Start. The grid for the double headers will be formed using the second fastest qualifying lap.

# 17. PRE RACE TESTING

# 18. OPERATION OF SAFETY CAR

A safety car will be on standby during both qualifying & racing. It will be deployed from the pit lane exit, in any race upon the sole decision of the Clerk of the Course **[Q 4.9.1].** It is the driver's responsibility to familiarise themselves with the operation of this and the *latest version* of the instructions, which are available on the MSA web site and MGCC Website on the Race Competitor Information Page.

# 19. RACE STOPS

Competitor's attention is drawn to the procedure operated by the Club in the event of any race being stopped. This is set out in full in the Club's 2016 **Standing Race Regulations**, which are available for download from the MGCC Motorsport web site.

# 20. SAFETY GUIDANCE

Guidance notes on safety at the circuit are also available for download on the web site and will be available at signing on. Please study these and comply with them at all times.
