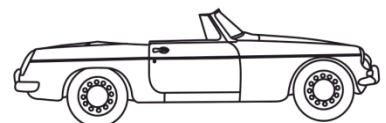
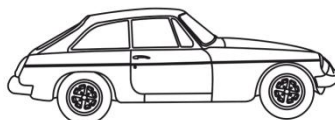
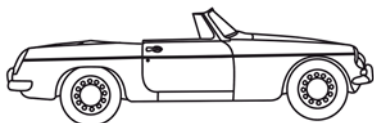

1	Door skin replacement	Demonstration on how to remove old door skin and to fit a new skin indicating points to watch and any tricks of the trade	
2	BMH Factory Tour	A conducted tour of the Witney premises	
3	AirFlow Products	Storing your MG and maintaing battery levels	
4	MGB Security	A discussion on simple items to improve MGB security, such as battery master switch, petrol pump switch steering wheel restraints, locking wheel nuts etc
