

Swiss MGC Days Tuesday 31st July to Wednesday August 8th 2018: - 50 Years of MGC in Switzerland

Information

As the first of the MGCs with destination Switzerland had been dispatched on January 15th 1968, this meeting marks the occasion of 50 years of MGCs in Switzerland.

We will be located in Central Switzerland around the so called "Seetal" (valley of the lakes; because the valley consists of two lakes), the "Baldeggersee" and the "Hallwilersee" which are located between Lenzburg and Lucerne.

From there we will explore many regions of Switzerland in almost every main geographic direction and there will be light tours followed by some extended tours – but with ample time to enjoy the runs as well as the relaxing stops.

Tuesday: Hotel check-in, welcome dinner

Wednesday: Scenic tour around the Seetal, Swiss National Day Dinner

Thursday: Scenic tour through the Entlebuch and the Emmental

Friday: Mountain-Tour Pragelpass – Klausenpass with a visit to the timekeepers-hut of the Klausen hillclimb race

Saturday: Visit to a farming-museum, local run in the area, anniversary dinner (50 years MGC in Switzerland)

Sunday: Visit to a local classic car meeting followed by a short run round the Rigi in Central Switzerland

Monday: Scenic tour to Eastern Switzerland (Canton Appenzell) with a visit to a cheese dairy

Tuesday: Visit to the Swiss Transport Museum at Lucerne and if time permits journey with a steam-paddler

Wednesday: Hotel check-out, farewell brunch

Each day there will be a light lunch along the tour and in the evenings there will be a dinner for all together at the hotel or a restaurant not too far from where we stay.

We aim for 15 to 30 MGCs for the full week – however there's no limitation on the numbers of cars.

We have already pre-reserved almost 30 rooms our main-stay hotel (Hotel Glashaus at Menziken AG;

<http://www.glashaus-hotel.ch/en-us/home>) and have another hotel in view which would allow to cover 40 cars – as usual the meeting application and hotel allocation is on a first come first served basis – therefore don't hesitate to apply early.

However it's very important that you apply soonest as we have to close the application latest by May 25th for organisational reasons (hotel room block-reservation and other reservations).

We are looking forward to welcome many interested MGC-friends from all over Europe (or even further away).
