# What is Drive It Day?

<u>Drive It Day</u> was created by the Federation of British Historic Vehicle Clubs in 2005. For one day a year, historical enthusiasts and the public come together to celebrate the One Thousand Mile Trial, first organised in 1900 to celebrate the motorcar. In 2021 the Federation Partnered with NSPCC's Childline and Drive It Day has raised over £100,000 to help support vulnerable children and young people.

The NSPCC is the leading children's charity fighting to end child abuse in the UK and Channel Islands. Using voluntary donations, which make up around 90 per cent of our funding, we help children who've been abused to rebuild their lives, we protect children at risk, and we find the best ways of preventing child abuse from ever happening again. Our Childline service provides a safe, confidential place for children with no one else to turn to, whatever their worry, whenever they need help. Children can contact Childline 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year.

Since partnering with NSPCC's Childline in 2021, Drive It Day has raised over £100,000 to help support vulnerable children and young people.

# **Crofton Beam Engines**

Crofton Beam Engines sit within a Grade I listed historic site, set in the East of Wiltshire. It is home to the oldest working beam engine in the world, still in its original location, still driven by steam and which can still perform its original task of keeping the Kennet and Avon canal supplied with water at its highest point. We have two engines which pump on "steaming days".

Our site will be open on the 21<sup>st</sup> of April from 10.30 to 16.30 to welcome visitors to the Grade I listed engine house where you can see our Lancashire Boiler, several standing engines, and of course our beam engines. Although not in steam on that day, we can provide car parking, access to the site and we will have a refreshment area to tempt visitors to buy tea, coffee and cake.

Many of our volunteers are also classic car enthusiasts and they will have some of their cars on display at Crofton Beam Engines and be taking part in Drive It Day.

You can get your exclusive Drive It Day rally plate at Crofton Beam Engines if you don't already have one. Access to the site is free for all. There is a charge for accessing the engine house but we are offering free access for drivers. 



We now have MG Car Club listed as a registered club in the dropdown menu of the website. <a href="https://">https://</a> www.shelsleywalsh.com/events-1/classic-nostalgia-car-clubs-2024

When members book, please ask them to click on to the 'Car Club' ticket option. When they add quantity and go thru to the next page, there's a drop down to select 'car club'. If they click scroll down to MG Car Club (there should be a MGC option) it will ensure that they get the ticket at the discounted price, and I get to know how many are booked in for your club. If they are a member of the MAC, they will still need to apply for a Car Club pass, and can do so on the website, again selecting your Club name, for the zone in which to park. I can keep you updated with how many members have booked etc.

Also, further event details are available on the Classic Nostalgia website, which will be updated regularly. At the moment, car club tickets are £15 per person, per day. £30 for the weekend if booked before the end of April. They then go up to £20 per day. Camping is permitted but guite limited and can also be booked online.

Our friends in Netherlands are organising their first MGC event, they already have some cars booked, from Switzerland & Germany and several from the UK. There is still 1 place available so be quick.
