Viewed in car footage, marshal evidence and videos from cars 16 and car 99 (car behind) with discussion with car 3 and car 16 drivers.

Car 3 was leading car 16 down the craner curves and understeered off the track onto the green tarmac at the exit of old hall corner (post 9). Rejoining he continued wide into the path of car 16 who had taken advantage to be alongside. Slight contact was made with car 16 making a spin and rejoining a number of places back. In mitigation car 3 had no mirror due to previous side to side contact however would have been aware of a driver in the area.
