Viewed circuit footage, marshal evidence and videos from cars 36 and car 80 (car behind) with discussion with car 23 and car 36 drivers.

Car 36 was overtaken by car 23 entering the right hand turn of the Esses. On exit of the corner, car 36 attempted to keep race with Car 23 by staying on the outside line of the track, leading to being on the kerbs / green section of the off circuit area. During exit of the corner onto the main pit straight car 36 nearside front corner contacted with car 23 offside rear corner leading to car 23 to loose control and take both cars into the barrier.
