Return of 'Old Number One' to the Land's End Trial

Return MG 'Old Number One' to the MCC Land's End Trial in 2025 – the Centenary of the car's Gold Medal Award in the hands of Cecil Kimber...

Provided by the British Motor Museum, Gaydon – the home of the world's largest collection of historic British cars, 'Old Number One', perhaps more accurately referred to as 'Kimber's Special', will be visiting Cornwall for the MCC Land's End Trial once again over the Easter weekend.

In 1925 Cecil Kimber won a gold medal aboard his early Morris Garages special which exists as an important stepping stone in the evolution towards the MG marque. Whilst earlier Morris Garages specials had been built, 'Old Number One' – Kimber's Special – was the first 'MG' purpose built for motorsport in seeking to capitalise upon the publicity from trials activity in the 1920s and establish the sporting credentials of the emerging marque.

With the Centenary of this significant motorcar from the MG story, comes the exciting opportunity to feature the return of this car to the modern-day location of Kimber's successful foray into motorsport.

With much work from the three partner organisations; the **British Motor Museum**; to whom we are especially grateful for providing one of their key exhibits, the **MCC**; in allowing us to dove-tail with their modern Trial event programme and to the **MG Car Club Devon & Cornwall Centre & Vintage Register** 'organising-team' for their considerable efforts in drawing this all together; we are collectively *delighted* to present the following event entry:
